

‘The Grace Outpouring’ by Roy Godwin and Dave Roberts

Recommended by Bishop Graham Dow, this is the story of how God worked in the Feald-y-Brenin retreat centre in rural Wales. Led by God to take up their role as directors at the centre, Roy and Daphne Godwin soon realised that God’s plans were for Feald-y-Brenin to become a ‘house of prayer’.

The Grace Outpouring tells many stories of dramatic manifestations of God’s presence, blessing and healing. Roy Godwin is honest about the process of discovery, questioning and searching.

I read through the whole book quickly, that tends to be the way I read, but the ideas are still developing for me. I have much more to explore in the whole theme developed in this book but praying blessing on those around me seems like an important place to start!

A favourite quote of mine from the book:

‘I don’t put huge value on these astonishing events and part of me is a little wary of even telling the stories.....We are seeking his presence not his manifestations....We just want them (people) to look for Jesus.’
